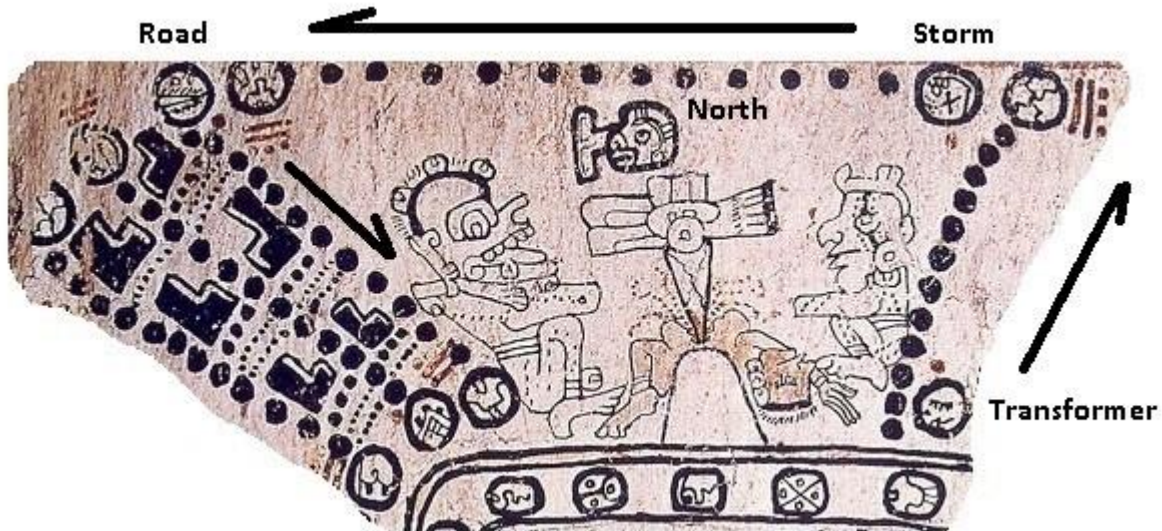


The Tzolk'in Clock – Storm Trecena

The storm (rainstorm) trecena is prominently located on the north face of the Tzolk'in Clock. This trecena is deeply connected to our sleep selves, the place we go when we are asleep. Spend time with meditation. Keep calm and placid waters in your mind and heart. Your sleep self is taking care of your future reality during this trecena. The Madrid codex north face looks gruesome; however, it represents transformation from awake to the place we go when we sleep, each night and ultimately death.



Depicted is an obsidian knife releasing energy from a human body which is laying on rock. Notice a big 'X' shown on the knife. There seems to be a spirit flying over the obsidian knife, holding it from its heart and overlooking the process. The Olmec, Aztec and Maya lived on this spiritual calendar. The Gregorian calendar captures your time and deflects your spiritual sense of time.

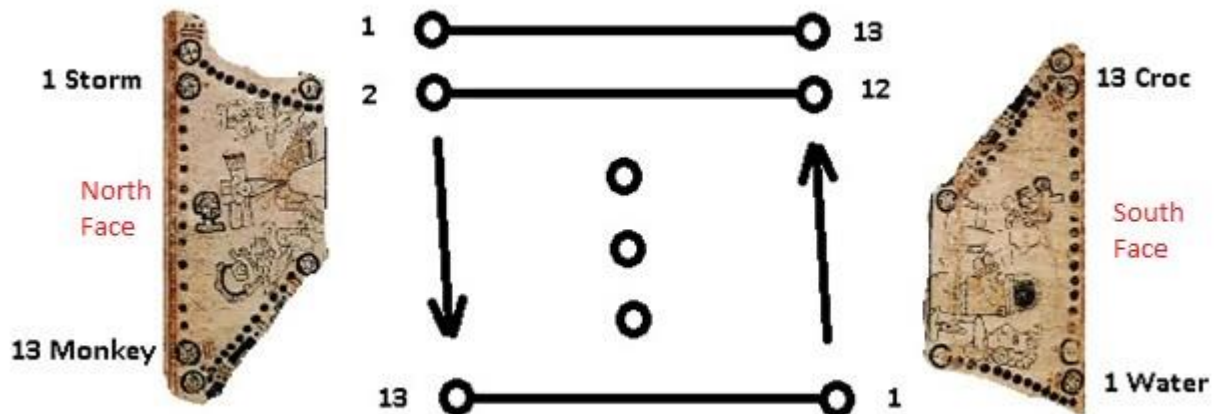
Waking up in the morning on the Gregorian calendar, do you ask yourself, “What day is it?”, “What time is it?”, and “How much free time do I have before getting ready?” In contrast, waking up on the Tzolk'in calendar, you ask yourself, “What is today's energy?”, “How am I feeling in relation to what I know about the day's energy?” and “What's the best way to handle today?”.

The Gregorian calendar way of living opposes the natural experience of the Tzolk'in Clock and especially this trecena. Separate yourself from it because this trecena is like being in the jungle, in the rain, naked and on rocks with water rushing by to feed plants and animals. There are no 9AM meetings scheduled for the north side of the Tzolk'in Clock. Save that energy for the south side of the Tzolk'in Clock (the opposite trecena is the water trecena). That trecena is the time to take physical action to fulfill your destiny. Sitting inside of the Tzolk'in Clock, facing east and with the walls folded



upwards, you can see there are outlooks that directly face each other. Could there be special connections between two outlooks? As you can see the 13 Crocodile outlook is directly opposite of the 1 Storm outlook, just as 1 Water is opposite of 13 Monkey. If there is a special relationship, it could be a

“soulmate” or the lack of narcissism in a relationship or even mind reading. Does the Tzolk’in Clock hold special patterns? Does 1 connect to 13 as shown, or does 1 connect to 12? If 1 connects to 12, then it explains the feeling of people born on the 13th day of a trecena, since they would not have a soulmate connection with anyone but connected with all other 13th day people. I believe the latter is true.



It would be good to have a retreat with 260 different people of each outlook. We could have activities that may or may not unlock some of these special patterns. For instance, would four people from each side of the Tzolk’in Clock, collectively, have a better view on an issue / situation than four people from the same side of the Tzolk’in Clock? Perhaps individually we lack the capstone of our consciousness and collectively we can gain complete understanding. We all have god-like power within us, but it has been capped off. Imagine collectively unlocking the full power of the Tzolk’in Clock.

The rainstorm trecena is the deepest spiritual trecena. It is equivalent to travelling through the right brain of consciousness. Dr. Jill Taylor explains the right brain of consciousness in her book, *A Stroke of Insight*. She describes the right brain (north face of the Tzolk’in Clock) as euphoria of the intuitive and a sense of complete well-being and peace. Comparing the Tzolk’in Clock to a human brain, the rainstorm trecena is deep in the right brain. This trecena is a time for meditation. Put pure ingredients into your body. It is a good time for fasting, purification and staying away from poisonous items like alcohol.

The Gregorian calendar way of living gives you self-created life. The Tzolk'in Clock way of living gives you our creator’s power. The north face, and especially this trecena, is the time to let your spiritual self take care of the plants growing in your heart, soul, and mind. Keep the materialistic way of living to a minimum so it does not interfere with your natural way of creating. The north face of the Tzolk’in Clock is the time to envision your future self, life, and surroundings. The seeds you planted on the east face are being farmed out by your sleep consciousness. Physically, there is not much that can be done. The growth happens naturally. Your best effort now is positive meditation and peace in your heart. Good things take a lot of work. Great things happen all at once. This trecena is about letting those great things manifest in our spiritual selves so they can be created in our physical reality.

Storm (Rainstorm) trecena on the Tzolk'in Clock

1 Rainstorm	Imagine the most perfect place on earth. This trecena is about being in that place both physically and spiritually. This rainstorm trecena is like being in the jungle with fresh water on stones next to plants and their shade from the sun.
2 Light	Associate with our Indian and Shaman ancestral past. This video may help. https://youtu.be/1FuGwkwm2k
3 Crocodile	What a difference a day makes. The duality of yesterday has cracked open and a new intention is emerging. It is a good feeling.
4 Wind	Be aware that you are aware. Soak in all the senses without fear of the future, nor regrets of the past, and loving the moment, continuously. Hold water that is clear, placid, and calm. Experience nature and watch the stars in the sky.
5 House	Today will strengthen your heart as this energy gives a constructive healing energy to your Akbal, or house, or internal flame.
6 Seed	Separate yourself from the materialistic life. Try to ignore the Gregorian calendar and your physical desires. Stay calm.
7 Serpent	Meditate on the water in your body. Take some water and pray into it. Open the magic in your heart and fill the water with light.
8 Transformer	Today is the "Day of the Dead". It is the day of the place you go to every time you fall asleep. Its energy connects with your ancestors.
9 Deer	The energy of this trecena is moving like tropical storm. Today's deer energy gives your strength and a solid foundation. The deer energy offers loving thoughts, loving words, loving inflections, loving actions. It revives your heart.
10 Star	Today you can step out of it, mentally, and appreciate life. It is not about the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow, just enjoy the rainbow.
11 Water	Today's energy is natural. Appreciate the art of humans and the majesty of nature. We are deep into this trecena and the heart of natural existence.
12 Dog	As the trecena ends, the reality of the Gregorian calendar is a heavy burden. Collectively we can be stronger without materialistic worries.
13 Monkey	This is the energy of a sunset on the ocean when the sun makes the shape of a cross in the sky and water and reflection. Enjoy today's energy. Tomorrow is 1 Road - "Ye shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free" energy.
