## The Tzolk'in Clock - Crocodile Trecena



Creating and planting your seeds gives awareness of the fertile ground. This trecena is about shaping the landscape of your mind, heart and spirit. Use the emergence of the crocodile trecena to strengthen your intentions.



These next three trecenas, on the east face of the Tzolk'in, surround the place where thoughts enter your mind. Humans are creative and this trecena is a celebration of that. Thoughts become ideas that become reality. Inventions, art, and music get their inspiration from human thought.

The east face of the Tzolk'in would go around the door that faces east in a Navajo hoogan with eight sides. This is the beginning of the east face of the Tzolk'in Clock. These next three trecenas surround the entry of thought into your mind, heart and spirit. This is the time to meditate on your intentions for this new Tzolk'in round. This is the trecena to offer your new seeds of intention to our collective consciousness.

The seven days and six nights of a trecena, relates to our seven chakras, too. The Tzolk'in is a personal, human calendar. It is multi-dimensional and carries our collective consciousness through time.



The human depicted in the center of the Aztec version of the Tzolk'in Clock, shows energy of the 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th chakras. Each of these energies connects to one of the faces of the Tzolk'in Clock. The feet, heart and head connect to the 1st, 4th and 7th chakras, respectively.

The Crocodile trecena is on the crown chakra energy. This is just one of many humanistic qualities of the Tzolk'in Clock. Thoughts are received through our crown chakra and processed through our heart chakra using the balance of our feet (grounding) chakra. As this Tzolk'in Clock manifests your seeds of thought into reality, it must pass through the humanistic chakra energies. This gives life to our Tzolk'in

round, as it connects our awake self with our spiritual self and our creator.

The day you were born has an assigned chakra that is more prevalent than the others. It's easy to spend too much energy focused on your birth chakra and that will lead to unbalance. I once asked a family of Mazatec shamans how to make my heart chakra larger and they said my heart chakra is fine, but my birth chakra is too large. Learn which chakra energy points at your Tzolk'in birthday and use it to benefit yourself and others. The goal is to balance all seven of your chakras and it helps to know how your chakra is connected to the Tzolk'in Clock.

The Tzolk'in Clock is embedded in the Aztec sun calendar (which has been misrepresented). The face in the center is not a blood thirsty sun. The face in the center is mother earth and she is speaking to us. She is speaking the message of the Tzolk'in to you, right now. The sun is not speaking. It is hidden as an eagle, which flies above us. You can see the eagle, in the center of this calendar, with its beak on top, claws on the side and feathers on the bottom. Your Tzolk'in birthday

Imagine living with the Maya around 800AD in the late classic period. People born on the day's intention would be part of the day's ceremonies. If today was 1-crocodile, then all people born on 1-crocodile would gather at the temple. They would be available for others to ask questions and discuss the day's energy. Elders, who received 1-crocodile as their new outlook, would also be included. People born with the 1st inflection of the trecena would stay at the temple for the entire trecena and be involved with special day and night ceremonies.

Imagine taking the power that you have, with your awake self, asleep self and our creator, and applying it collectively as a people. You can create reality! Imagine if hundreds and thousands of people were working together to create their collective reality, using the Tzolk'in calendar; collectively planting seeds yields greater abundance than individually planting seeds.

A profound Hopi prophecy exists saying this is the time for the re-unification of people from east, west, north and south. The Tzolk'in Clock is the center of all four directions. It's the genetic code of time and it is rebirthing currently. The Tzolk'in is a beacon for all to follow. It's about peace and love and understanding our creator of this physical realm and time. This calendar does not discriminate and includes everyone.

## Crocodile trecena

1 Crocodile	It's the eyes of the crocodile that sees above the water while its body is immersed in water. It's the energy of emergence.
2 Wind	It's the breath of our creator. It's the duality of thoughts and choices.
3 House	Taking the energy of wind and placing in your heart (house) for your intention.
4 Seed	Your intention is ready for your spiritual self to receive.
5 Serpent	The energy of life is given to your seed, to grow into your reality, with the help of your creator, spiritual self, and the Tzolk'in Clock.
6 Transformer	Your seeds are now with your spiritual self.
7 Deer	The stability of the Deer intention brings you fully into your awake self. Immerse yourself in nature.
8 Star	Immerse yourself in the sky, the sun, moon, and wandering stars.
9 Water	Your internal waters are flowing. Shape the path of your water to improve your soil. Take control of your energies.
10 Dog	This is a fun day. It's a day to use your 10 fingers to make music and your ten toes to dance. Your rocks have been lifted, today is the day to let them roll. If your inflection is 10, this is your dog day, too.
11 Monkey	It's time to think again. You've seen your fields, you've planted your crops, and your spiritual self is aware. Think where to place your energy.
12 Road	Today is the abundance of grass. You can walk all over grass, yet it grows and grows. Appreciate all your landscape, give yourself blessings.
13 Reed	Feel god appreciate you. Our purpose is love and god shows his appreciation for you today. Rest, relax, and feel the love within you.
